Dear Cuddington Parents and Families,

Thank you to all of you who attended our Parent Briefing on Monday evening – a whopping 87% of our families were able to attend. At this briefing I talked through;

- ALL children return on Monday 8th March (and we are all overjoyed)!
- Stringent risk assessments are still in place; *enhanced hand hygiene, children in bubbles, staggered start and finish times, the 3 entrances are still to be used, bubble closure should a member of staff or a child report a positive test result*
- The children's curriculum is around 'reconnecting' NOT 'recovery' – we are seeking to secure your child's independence, resilience and positive learning behaviours
- Please read the attached Behaviour Addendum (it can also be found on our website)
- We asked parents to give their views on what they would like the educational provision to be when their children return (*please complete the parent questionnaire on school spider*)
- We will be asking your children for their views on what they want for their return
- Our planned virtual parents' evening will be during wb 24th May 2021

It was stressed at the meeting that all 'lockdown' rules will remain in place when your child returns to school. Parents were urged to continue to follow the rules. If we all do our bit, then transmission will continue to fall and rules can start to be relaxed.

- One adult to bring their child and to collect at the end of the day
- Any adult bringing their child MUST wear a facemask when on the school site.
- Please ensure a 2m distance from other adults whilst waiting to collect your child
- DO NOT stand close to each other outside the school gates and chat; please drop your child off and leave.

School Uniform

We had a question about school uniform and since then quite a few telephone queries.

Part of our children reconnecting with each other will be to wear their school's uniform. It goes some way to prepare our children to 'get ready' for school. Mrs Clarke has emailed you separately with details of ordering any uniform requirements online.

We understand that school shoes may be an issue initially as there are no shoe shops open right now (although there are supermarkets which sell shoes). Where possible, please endeavour to provide black footwear for your child.

Please provide your child's PE kit in their same drawstring bag. We would like to minimise large numbers of large bags coming to and from school. Reading bags will now be permitted as reading books will be coming home following your teacher's assessment of their reading.



World Maths Day (3rd March) and World Book Day (4th March)

Next Wednesday and Thursday we will be celebrating our love for Maths and reading by immersing ourselves in Maths for a full day and Reading for a full day. This could mean engaging in a variety of related activities away from the screen.

It will be during this time, where your child's class teachers will be planning and preparing lessons for your child's return. They will be organising their classrooms to ensure real familiarity for your child's return (you can tell we are all so excited can't you)?!

Next week, there will be further information emailed out to you, focused more on lunchtime arrangements and snack reminders.
