
Parking

There continues to be unlawful parking outside of school and we continue to be worried about potential accidents as a result of this. Please could I ask that you all park safely and lawfully at the front or back of school to ensure the safety of everyone.

COVID 19

We are moving closer and closer to the government's next stage of the roadmap out of lockdown. The next stage is 17th May should the data around transmission and hospital admissions remain as low as they are currently. We are still not allowed to go into each others' houses and school staff remain vigilant in school to ensure bubbles of children are not needing to isolate. Let's continue to work together to keep our community safe and ready to move into the next stage. We are also waiting for the DfE updates to school recommendations and risk assessments.

Senior Leaders and Governors continue to wait for an update to the statutory requirement of the end of year reporting to parents. As a trust of 3 schools, we are administering end of year assessments to Year 2 – Year 6 in Reading and Maths to secure effective transition to their next teacher (school) and to quality assure our curriculum in the time we have had this year. We will be teacher assessing



end of year attainment for Reception and Year 1, with year 1 children accessing the end of year phonic screening check, to determine strengths in decoding and gaps we will need to fill as they move into year 2.

Mental Health Awareness Week

Next week is Mental Health Awareness Week. Each class will be completing a task to raise awareness of this very important area – Cuddington will be ‘pressing pause’ again. Look out for our tweets next week!
